The Safe and Sober Free Cab Ride Home program will be available in Terre Haute and West Terre Haute from 10 p.m. on Thursday, December 31, 2009, through 4 a.m. on Friday, January 1, 2010.

To request a free cab ride home, call Yellow Cab of Terre Haute at (812) 478-5000 and tell them Fleschner Law is paying for your safe ride home.

- People must call Yellow Cab of Terre Haute and mention the program to get a free ride home.
- Cab rides are provided from a bar or restaurant to an individual's residence—not to other drinking locations.
- Due to the high number of ride requests on New Year's Eve, rides cannot be guaranteed for everyone who calls; however, every attempt will be made to accommodate all requests. Drivers have the right to use their discretion when accepting fares.
